STUDY BACKGROUND



The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) is conducting a corridor study of 278th Street in Lincoln County in South Dakota from S.D. Highway 115 to S.D. Highway 11.

The study will focus on the traffic impacts from the planned South Dakota Department of Corrections (DOC) Men's Prison Facility. The SDDOT is working to identify and meet the transportation infrastructure needs for current and projected traffic growth generated by the planned DOC facility. The SDDOT is developing a plan to identify the necessary transportation infrastructure improvements and timeline for implementation to address those needs.

This study builds upon previous studies, forecasts, and analyses to identify any additional needs and update timelines for implementation. The study includes traffic data collection and forecasts, traffic operations analysis, crash history review, environmental review, concept development and evaluation, public engagement, and recommendations.

Develop and evaluate concepts to address potential operational needs




Develop recommendations for 278th Street corridor modifications








STUDY AREA MAP
